

Visitor Charter

We at Arundel House are working toward being more environmentally aware and wish to promote this by working with our Guests.

Please help us to reduce our carbon footprint by:

1. Switching off the lights when leaving your room.
2. Switching off your TV when it's not in use instead of leaving it on standby. A TV left on standby uses 95% of its energy on that little red dot!
3. Not running water to excess.
4. Following our green towels policy by placing only the towels you wish to be replaced in your sink or shower when leaving your room.
5. Leaving your car in our free car park and walking for five minutes to Cheddar Gorge instead of driving. It is cheaper, uses fewer emissions and is better for the environment and for you.
6. Leaving your car in our free car park and walking to your choice of pub or restaurant instead of driving. All of Cheddar's pubs and restaurants are within a 10 minute walk of Arundel House.
7. Using local public transport where possible instead of driving.
8. Helping us to recycle. There are recycling bins for glass bottles, plastic bottles, tetra cartons and tin cans by the big blue bin in the car park. Bins for paper and cardboard are underneath the fire escape by the kitchen door.
